NYSACCME TO OFFER CORONER 101 CLASS FEBRUARY 2018

With the passage of the Training Bill A5780A in August, NYSACCME will now offer the Coroner 101 Class EVERY YEAR in the month of February. Per the language contained in the Bill, a newly elected/appointed Coroner must take a basic course in Medicolegal Death Investigation within 90 days of being elected/appointed to Public Office. We have received many inquiries as to who pays for this class. It is the responsibility of THE OFFICE HOLDER to take this class. Whether or not the County chooses to pay for it or not, THE OFFICE HOLDER MUST take this class. It is a non-funded mandate meaning the County does NOT have to pay for it if they choose not to do so. That DOES NOT exclude the Office Holder from having to take the class. For those who want a refresher, we also invite you to join us.

Coroner 101 Class will be held on Saturday, February 24, 2018, 8:00am-5:30pm, (7-8am Registration and Breakfast) at the Genesee Grande Hotel in Syracuse. Your reservations and accommodations are made by the NYSACCME Office. Please review and complete the enclosed CORONER 101 Registration Form and mail along with payment (check or money order) to the NYSACCME Office. **Deadline to register is Friday, January 26, 2018.** There is limited seating available. There will be NO day-of registration.
